

Caldecott Hall Seniors Section competition, 2025 Singles Knockout Matchplay.

This competition will be played under the Rules of Golf & Caldecott Hall golf clubs local rules. (In addition the following competition specific rules will apply & override the similar club competition rules– see below)

Format: Singles Knockout **MATCHPLAY**. This competition will not count towards order of merit competition. Scorecards will NOT be used for handicap purposes. Scorecards do not need to be handed in.

Tee to be used: Yellow tee boxes. Matches MUST commence on hole 1.

Tee time: Players to arrange their own, mutual agreeable, tee time. (See full requirements further down sheet)

Eligibility: Open to all Caldecott hall seniors who have paid their additional annual section subscription & who have a WHS handicap. Maximum WHS handicap allowance of 28. Players need to have submitted 5 eligible WHS scorecards in the last 12 months for each round match date, as per club rules.

How to Enter: Players must put their name down to play, on the Notice board entry form, **making sure they are eligible to enter & will remain so for each round**, by the Cut off date of midday (12 noon) 26/2/2025.

Entry fee: Free to all Caldecott hall seniors who have paid their additional annual section subscription

Handicap allowance: 100% of course handicap off yellow tees. Use England golf handicap calculator (**NOT THE BOARDS**) or get Seniors Captain / pro shop to work out correct handicaps prior to play, as things have changed.

Prizes: Trophy to winner and £25 club voucher. Runner up receives £10 club voucher.

Order of play: Knockout events: Order of play, in the first round, the first person drawn goes first. Additional rounds, order of play is determined by drawing lots at the tee.

If additional holes are required to determine a winner, the Sudden death extra holes will commence again from hole 1 with the same handicap allowances still counting, as per first 18 holes, on each extra hole. Order of play continues on from last hole played as it is a continuation of the round, not a new round.

Winners of each round to update draw sheet ASAP.

Knockout events: All entrants must give their contact telephone number to the pro shop to enable contact with opponents to arrange a suitable date/time for the match. Each Match **MUST** be completed by the last round date specified in the draw and NO extensions will be allowed.

All players are jointly responsible for ensuring that within 7 days of the round draw, their opponent is contacted and a MINIMUM of 6 dates/times must be given to the opponent for the match to take place. These must include wherever possible, weekdays/ weekends, morning and afternoon/evening times. It is encouraged that as many dates/times are put forward as possible to ensure the Match does take place. Should there be NO agreement made, then the person that turns up on the first Tee at 1pm on the last day of the round draw date, ready to play, will be declared winner of that round. (Confirm with Seniors Captain at that time that your opponent has not turned up) If both players turn up at that time then the Match will proceed ASAP on that same day. If a person doesn't want to play/isn't able to play, by the round end date, then they will concede the match to their opponent.(This will discourage persons from deliberately avoiding play). Any disputes will be resolved by the committee.

Competition Results: The result of the complete competition will be declared Final by the committee posting the result on the club notice board. In the case of disputes, the result will only become Final after they have finished the investigation and they will then post the Final result on the club notice board. The winner and runner up will be notified of the result at this time.
